Its strong and diverse portfolio of market-leading brands and best-in-class products provides its 13 million customers excitement and entertainment in a safe and responsible way. Brands include Paddy Power, Sky betting and gaming, Betfair, Sportsbet, BetEasy, Foxbet, FanDuel, and PokerStars.

Role purpose:

Our vision for global technology is to achieve competitive advantage for our divisions by collaborating on areas of technology that benefit from global scale, while maintaining divisional autonomy in other areas and ensuring our customers are safe.

Achieving our vision and maximising the potential of the 4500+ technologists in the Flutter group will involve significant change in all areas of Technology, as well as other related functions.

Reporting to the Programme Director, the Project Manager will lead the planning and delivery of multi-faceted, cross-divisional projects as part of our commitment to deliver the Cyber Security Strategy utilising the risk-based security policy framework and robust governance and compliance capability.

Responsible for:

- Partnering with key stakeholders from across the Flutter technology team, divisional technology teams
 and, where necessary, third-party vendors to define project scopes and plans for the delivery of our Cyber
 Security strategic initiatives.
- To create and deliver all aspects of the project plan, ensuring milestones are met, budgets are managed, and outcomes are achieved.
- To establish the appropriate governance structures and reporting processes, ensuring that all issues are addressed and resolved in a timely fashion.
- To manage any third-party vendor in liaison with our legal, technology and business teams ensuring that all contractual and SLA obligations are adhered to.
- Where necessary, to work with teams across the group to ensure change is effectively embedded.
- Fostering an organisational culture that embraces and thrives on change.
- Serving as a role model in the promotion of the Group's position on responsible gambling.
